Refusal to release information to the Military Recruiters, Media & Third Parties Hoonah City School District

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Federal & State laws protect the permanent record information of your child. A policy is in effect for the Hoonah City School District that maintains confidentiality of the student data.

Occasionally, the school may need to distribute limited information about all students, such as at graduation time, in athletic programs, in the year book or in school newspapers. Such material is classified as "Directory Information." Also, schools routinely release the names, addresses and phone numbers of secondary students to military recruiters and institutions of higher learning unless parents opt out. If you do not object in writing, the school will distribute such information as needed.
